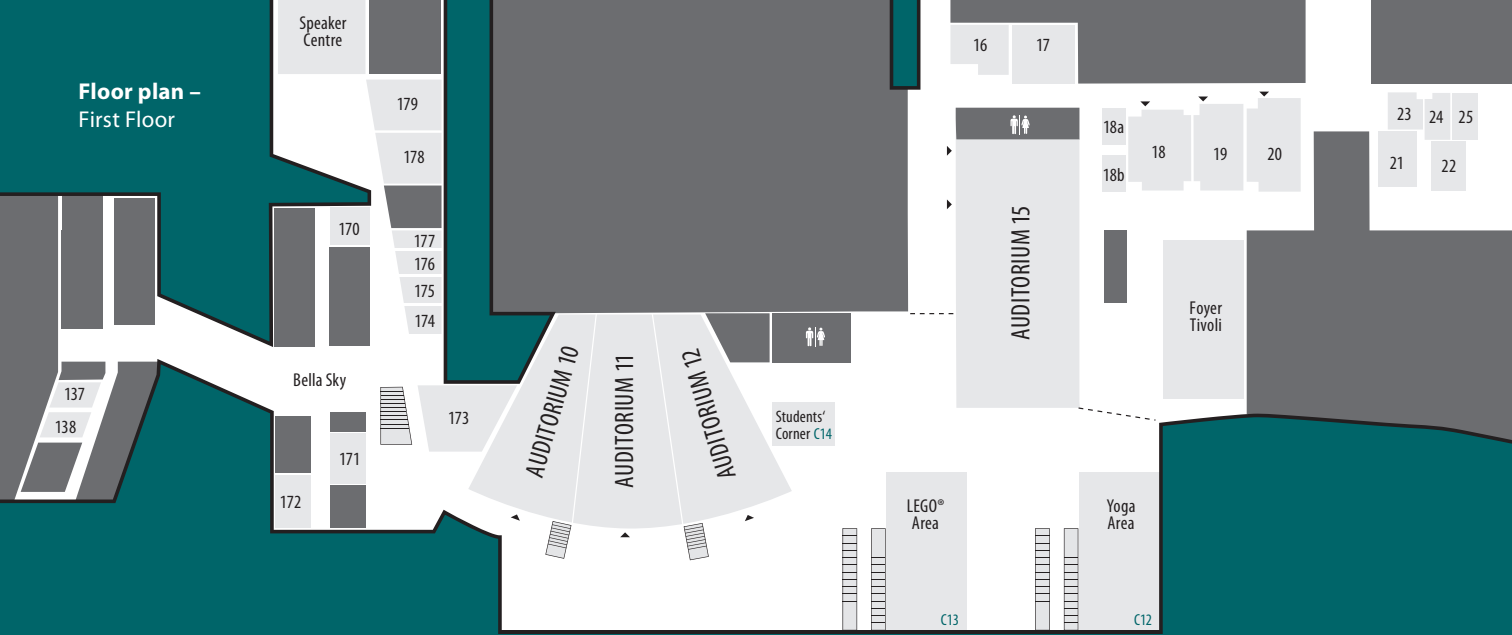

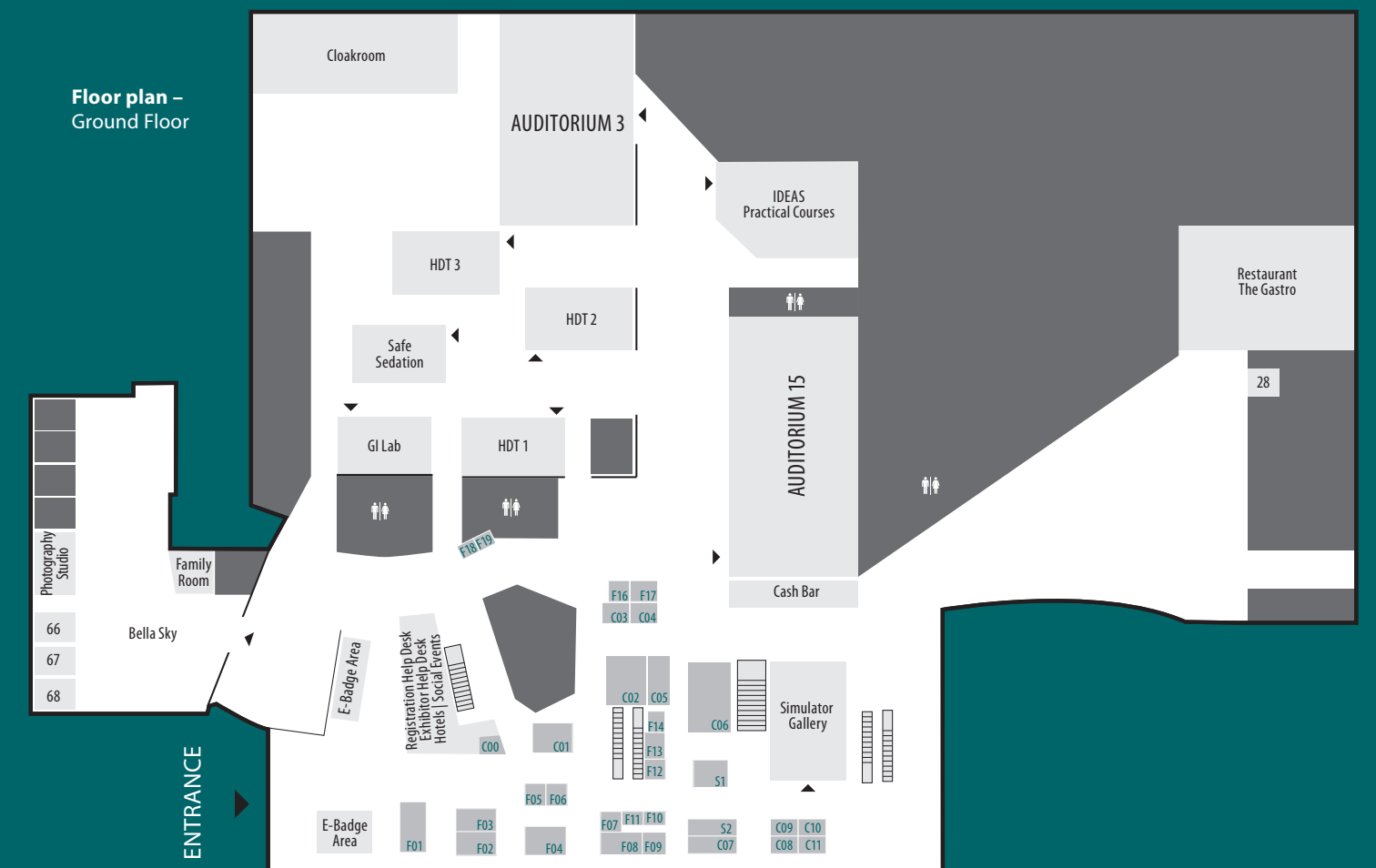


Floor plan – Exhibition

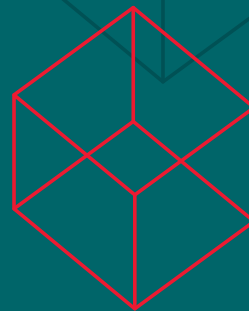
